Children's Mental Health Week - 9th to 13th February

The theme is 'This is My Place' and we will be marking the week with special assemblies, creating a whole-school display and thinking about activities to promote our own mental health and sense of belonging.

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Debating Competition

On Tuesday we held a heat of the 'Cicero Cup' - the national debating competition for primary schools. Our six children all showed great confidence, passion and quick thinking when discussing the issues of whether we should tax junk food and whether e-sports should be taught in school.

Highlights included Dora being named as one of the 'Star Speakers' for her opening argument of the day which the Judge described as 'fun and personable' and Annabel leaving one of the other competitors silent after answering his question so effectively. While we didn't progress to the next round this year, everyone had a great time and learned a lot about the art of debate.



Year 6 Science

In science, Year 6 have been studying the circulatory system. So far, the children have investigated a real lamb's heart to help them understand the structure of the heart and this week they have made a model of the components of blood using cheerios (red blood cells), oats (platelets), marshmallows (white blood cells) and coloured water (plasma).



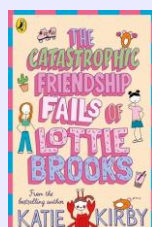
Dance Workshop
