### Don't forget: Wraparound Care payment changing in September

As I wrote to you on 19th April, from September 2024, we will be changing to a system where you book and pay in advance for your childcare rather than being billed afterwards. This can be a lump sum or by instalments.

This change is because we currently have a very significant amount in outstanding debts waiting to be paid to us which is making the wraparound care become unviable – it is an additional provision and we cannot and will not cover the debts from school funds intended for all children.

Further details on the new system will follow in the summer term, but we wanted to give you as much notice as possible so that you can plan ahead with your budgeting for next school year. As this will mean a change to how you pay for the childcare on offer, we will be freezing the prices for 2024/25 to help with planning for the costs.

#### What's on the menu?

We have happily seen an improvement in the school meals over the last couple of months and will continue to work with the caterers to make these as enjoyable as possible for the children.

#### **Comic Book Artist Inspiration**





