All parents and carers are welcome to apply and places will be filled on a first come first served basis. Through our relationship with Parent Gym, the programme is free of charge to you.


Each weekly session lasts two hours, and will take place in Juniper Room (refreshments available) on Tuesdays as below:






Birthday Book Donations
